Notice of Race & Addendum to Sailing Instructions (5/10/12)

1 RULES

- 1.1 Races will be governed by the rules as defined in rules 1-84 and 89-91, plus the Appendices and Definitions, of the "The Racing Rules of Sailing" and by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 Racing shall be conducted in boats manufactured, equipped, and rigged in conformity with the rules of the International Laser Class Association, except that Intensity sails may be used as alternatives to the official Laser class sails.
- 1.4 Laser Class membership is encouraged but not required.
- 1.5 USCG-approved PFD must be worn.
- 1.6 Appendix S will be used.
- 1.7 Racing rule 61.1(a) is changed for protest filings. Racing rule 60.1(a) will be changed for disqualifications. Racing rule A4.1 will be changed for check-in procedure. Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are modified to require a one turn penalty including one tack and one gybe. The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.8 This Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions may be modified by the Cedar Point Fleet-Specific Addenda to the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions. If no applicable modification exists in the Fleet-Specific Addenda, then this Notice of Race shall serve as the governing document.
- 1.9 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The Cup Weekend Races are open to all club members, including winter members, and their guests. While the Cup weekends are not "open" regattas, it is expected that any non-member wishing to participate under the Rules will be considered a "guest" for that day.

3 FEES

There are NO entry fees and all boats from any area are invited to join.

4 QUALIFYING AND SCORING

- 4.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will be used, with 1 throwout for each 5 races sailed. Rules A2 and A4.2 are modified by changing the word series to day.
- 4.2 Qualification and scoring rules may be modified by the Cedar Point Yacht Club Fleet-Specific Addenda to the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions.

5 SCHEDULE

First warning signal is scheduled for 1300 on the listed dates.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions and this Addendum will be in the breezeway at CPYC and/or on the Club's web site, www.cedarpointyc.org. There may be a limited supply available on the RC boat.

7 VENUE

The racing area will be in the area immediately SE of the mouth of the Saugatuck River, or if conditions warrant, on the “flats” of the river mouth just outside the CPYC basin.

8 COURSES

The courses and marks will be defined by the CPYC Sailing Instructions.

9 RADIO COMMUNICATION AND EQUIPMENT

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

10 PRIZES

CPYC glasses will only be awarded for the top three finishers based on scoring for the Cup Weekend. Season prizes for each fleet will be determined in accordance with the Cedar Point Trophy Policy, outlined below:

Points are multiplied by a dollar value, depending on budget, to determine approximate amount to be spent on a trophy.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 INSURANCE

Insurance coverage is up to the discretion of the owner of each boat. Skippers are reminded that they may be personally liable for damages resulting from contact between boats or race committee vessel from the time they leave the dock until they return to the dock.
